**About the Course...**

CNLA's annual certification program gives up-to-date knowledge and expertise that promotes horticultural professionalism within our industry. This annual 13-week course will teach you the basics of botany, plant identification, and professional technological information.

CNLA's low admission price — just \$100 for members (\$150 for non-members) — makes accreditation open to all people in the nursery and landscape industry. The designation, *Connecticut Accredited Nursery Professional*, will be awarded in special ceremonies at the CNLA Winter Symposium in January. [Following the 13 class sessions, an examination is given to those persons wishing to attain "Accredited Nursery Professional" status.] And now your accreditation will be honored in all 6 New England states.

Most classes are held from 7:00pm-9:00pm each Tuesday night beginning August 18 at Southington High School. Instructors are Dr. Mark Brand, Dawn Pettinelli, Steve Rackliffe (all from University of Connecticut), Amy Sampson (Naugatuck Valley Community College) and Dan Dalton (NVCC).
